



## Set topic for the club competitions in 2021

**Through a window:** The picture can be of anything, looking in or looking out, but the window must be evident in the image.

**Landscapes:** Your pictures can include water and sky, but land should form at least 60% of the image. Man-made structures can be included e.g. buildings, bridges, pylons etc, but they must not be dominant in the scene.

**Patterns in nature:** In this context a pattern is a regularly repeated shape or design. Patterns can be found in many natural objects such as leaves, feathers, flowers etc.

**In the street:** Generally known as “street photography”, pictures can show any activity / people taken outdoors in an urban environment. Many good street photographs are taken as candid shots, and while it is legal to take photographs of people in a public place, be careful that you don’t offend anyone by invading their space. If your photos include children it is always best to ask permission of the parents first.

**Selective focus:** The aim here is to control depth of field in order to bring an object or person into focus while the rest of the image is out of focus.
